

EVENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

Alice in Wonderland - Mountain Rave (Indoor & Outdoor)

Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully before purchasing your ticket. By completing your ticket purchase you confirm that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions in full.

1. Event Details

Event Type: Mountain Rave

Venue Type: Mountain Location - Indoor & Outdoor

2. Ticket Purchase & Sales

Tickets for this event are sold exclusively through Eventfrog. All ticket purchases are subject to these Terms and Conditions as well as the Eventfrog platform terms of service.

2.1 Ticket Confirmation

Upon successful purchase, you will receive a booking confirmation via email. This confirmation serves as proof of purchase. Please retain it and present it (digitally or printed) at the venue entrance.

3. Age Restriction

This event is strictly restricted to individuals aged 21 years and over.

- Valid government-issued photo identification (passport, national ID card, or driving license) must be presented at the entrance.
 - Anyone who cannot provide valid ID proving they are aged 21 or over will be refused entry without refund.
 - The organizer reserves the right to conduct ID checks at any point during the event.

4. No-Refund Policy

All ticket sales are final. Tickets are non-refundable and non-exchangeable under any circumstances, including but not limited to:

- Change of personal plans or inability to attend
- Illness or injury prior to the event

- Travel disruptions or adverse weather conditions
- Refusal of entry due to failure to comply with event rules or age verification

In the unlikely event that the organizer cancels or significantly alters the event (e.g., change of date or venue), ticket holders will be informed via the email address provided at the time of purchase. In such circumstances only, the organizer will outline the options available to ticket holders.

5. Liability Waiver & Assumption of Risk

5.1 Personal Responsibility

By attending this event, each guest acknowledges and agrees that participation involves inherent risks. Each attendee is solely responsible for their own safety, health, and well-being throughout the entire event, including before, during, and after.

5.2 Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the organizer, its employees, contractors, volunteers, and agents shall not be liable for:

- Any personal injury, illness, or death sustained at or in connection with the event
- Loss, theft, or damage to personal property
- Any incidents or accidents occurring on or off the event premises
- Any indirect, consequential, or incidental loss of any kind

This limitation applies regardless of whether such loss, damage, or injury arises from negligence, breach of contract, or any other cause.

5.3 Outdoor & Mountain Environment

This event takes place at an indoor and outdoor mountain location. Attendees acknowledge that outdoor environments carry additional inherent risks including, but not limited to, uneven terrain, variable weather conditions, and limited emergency response access. Guests are advised to wear appropriate footwear and clothing and to take personal precautions accordingly.

6. Guest Conduct & Entry Requirements

All guests are expected to behave in a respectful and responsible manner at all times. The organizer reserves the right to refuse entry to, or eject from the venue, any person who:

- Is under the influence of alcohol or substances to a degree deemed unsafe by event staff
- Displays aggressive, threatening, or antisocial behavior
- Fails to comply with the instructions of event staff or security personnel
- Is in possession of prohibited items (see Section 7)
- Attempts to gain entry without a valid ticket

Guests ejected from the event for the above reasons will not be entitled to a refund.

7. Prohibited Items

The following items are strictly prohibited on the event premises:

- Weapons or items that could be used as weapons
- Any item deemed dangerous or inappropriate by event staff

The organizer reserves the right to conduct bag searches and confiscate prohibited items.

8. Health & Safety

Guests with pre-existing medical conditions are advised to consult their physician prior to attending. In the event of a medical emergency, please alert event staff immediately.

Consumption of alcohol is at the guest's own risk. The organizer reserves the right to refuse service of alcohol to any individual.

9. Photography, Recording & Image Rights

This is a private event. Guests are welcome to take photos and videos for personal memory purposes. However, if you do not wish to be photographed or filmed by other guests, please communicate this directly to the individual concerned or notify a staff member, who will assist you. We ask all attendees to be respectful of each other's privacy and to honor any requests not to be photographed.

10. Data Protection & Privacy

Personal data collected during the ticket purchase process is processed in accordance with applicable data protection legislation (including the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection,

nDSG) and the Eventfrog privacy policy. Your data will be used solely for the purposes of event management and communication.

11. Force Majeure

The organizer shall not be held liable for any failure or delay in performing obligations under these Terms where such failure or delay results from circumstances beyond the organizer's reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, extreme weather, government orders, pandemics, or civil unrest.

12. Amendments to These Terms

The organizer reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time. Ticket holders will be notified of any material changes via the contact details provided at the time of purchase. Continued attendance at the event following notification of changes constitutes acceptance of the updated Terms.

13. Governing Law

These Terms and Conditions are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Switzerland. Any disputes arising in connection with these Terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Switzerland.
