§ 01

Festival Attendees PsyRiver 2026 and Contractual Basis

The term "Festival Attendee PsyRiver 2026" refers to any natural person who purchases, holds, or enters the festival grounds with a ticket.

By purchasing a ticket, entering the festival grounds, or using any infrastructure, the Festival Attendee PsyRiver 2026 expressly and fully agrees to these Terms and Conditions as well as the House Rules of the Organiser.

These Terms and Conditions form an integral part of the contractual relationship between the Festival Attendee PsyRiver 2026 and the Organiser.

§ 02

Authority and Enforcement

The Organiser exercises house authority over the entire festival grounds and all associated areas (incl. camping, parking, and infrastructure).

THE INSTRUCTIONS OF THE FOLLOWING PERSONS MUST BE FOLLOWED WITHOUT RESTRICTION

- Security staff
- Organisation team
- Authorised personnel

In the event of non-compliance, the Organiser is entitled to take measures, in particular:

- Removal from the grounds
- Exclusion from the festival and campsite
- Confiscation of items
- Involvement of police or authorities

Exclusion may occur at any time and without prior warning. No refund will be issued.

§ 03

Ticket Conditions

Tickets are personal and may only be transferred via the official ticketing platform.

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT PERMITTED

- Commercial resale
- Misuse of tickets
- Manipulation of tickets

The Organiser reserves the right to cancel tickets without compensation in the event of misuse.

Loss, theft, or damage to tickets is the sole responsibility of the Festival Attendee PsyRiver 2026. No replacement will be provided.

All ticket purchases are final and non-refundable. This applies equally to tickets purchased incorrectly (e.g. wrong ticket category, wrong date). The purchase is binding and definitive.

§ 04

Entry and Grounds for Exclusion

Entry may be refused or revoked, in particular in cases of:

- Violation of the Terms and Conditions or House Rules
- Violence, threats, or aggressive behaviour
- Racist, discriminatory, or sexist conduct
- Sexual assault or harassment
- Theft or criminal acts
- Significant disruption of the event
- Severe intoxication

- Consumption, possession, or overdose of illegal substances
- Carrying prohibited items (glass bottles, personal drinks in glass or plastic containers > 1 litre, weapons, sharp objects, professional cameras with interchangeable lenses, drones)
- Endangering one's own safety or that of others

Persons under the age of 18 may only attend accompanied by a legal guardian or with a written consent form from their legal guardian.

The decision to exclude a person is at the sole discretion of the Organiser and is carried out with the involvement of security staff.

§ 05

Liability Waiver and Personal Responsibility

Attendance at the festival grounds is entirely at the individual's own risk.

The Organiser accepts no liability – to the extent permitted by law – for:

- Personal injury or property damage
- Loss or theft of belongings
- Health-related damage of any kind

THIS APPLIES IN PARTICULAR TO HEALTH AND CONSUMPTION

- Allergies or intolerances (food, beverages, environmental factors)
- Health reactions to heat, cold, dust, or natural conditions
- Consumption of food and drinks from any catering operator on site

All catering on the grounds is consumed at the sole responsibility of the Festival Attendee.

§ 06

Natural Hazards and Grounds

The festival takes place in a natural outdoor environment. Possible risks include:

- Uneven terrain
- Weather conditions
- Plants, animals, and insects
- Limited visibility

By entering the grounds, all attendees explicitly accept these risks.



§ 07

Liability Outside the Festival Grounds – Aare River

The Aare River is located outside the festival grounds and falls entirely outside the Organiser's area of responsibility.

Swimming is entirely at your own risk. This is not an official swimming area. No supervision is provided – neither by the Organiser, nor by the municipality, nor by the landlord of the grounds.

All liability is fully excluded.

§ 08

External Infrastructure – Radelfingen Sports Facility

The Radelfingen sports facility may only be used during the defined hours and in accordance with the house rules applicable there.

THE INFRASTRUCTURE INCLUDES IN PARTICULAR

- Showers
- Hot water
- Toilets

Violations of the rules may result in loss of access and exclusion from the festival.

§ 09

Camping, Vehicles and Parking

9.1 General Rules

Camping and parking are only permitted in the designated areas. The grounds are located on agricultural land made temporarily available for the event.

9.2 Wild Camping and Violations

Wild camping is strictly prohibited. In the event of violations:

- Vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense
- Tents will be removed and disposed of

- Access to the festival and campsite will be denied
- No refund will be issued

9.3 Marshalling

Campers and vehicles will be directed by security staff. These instructions are binding. Failure to comply may result in denial of access.

9.4 Liability and Damage

In the event of littering, soil contamination, or damage to areas and infrastructure, the responsible party will be charged for cleaning costs, repair costs, and any applicable fines.

§ 10

Quiet Hours and Noise Control

From 00:00 midnight, strict quiet hours apply on the campsite, external parking areas, and surrounding zones.

THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED

- Music systems
- Sound systems
- Excessive noise

Violations will result in confiscation of equipment and exclusion from the festival.

§ 11

Fire, Cooking and Pyrotechnics

Open fire is only permitted in expressly designated areas. Outside these areas, fire is at the individual's own risk – the Organiser accepts no liability.

Pyrotechnic items (incl. fireworks) may be prohibited at any time and confiscated if necessary. This applies in particular in cases of drought, wind, or official directives.



§ 12

Trade and Commercial Activity

All commercial activity is prohibited without prior written authorisation. This includes:

- Sale of goods
- Services
- Promotion

Violations will result in confiscation of goods and immediate exclusion.

§ 13

Media and Recordings

THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED

- Commercial recordings without written authorisation from the Organiser
- Drone flights of any kind

By entering the grounds, attendees consent to the creation of photo and video recordings and their use for marketing and documentation purposes.

The processing of personal data is carried out exclusively in accordance with the Organiser's separate Privacy Policy, available at www.psyriver.ch/datenschutz.

§ 14

Pets

Pets are not permitted.

EXCEPTION

- Officially recognised assistance dogs



§ 15

Force Majeure

In the event of circumstances beyond the Organiser's control, including in particular:

- Natural disasters
- Extreme weather conditions
- Official orders or directives
- Pandemics

...the festival may be restricted, postponed, or cancelled.

In such cases, the Organiser will endeavour to offer a reasonable solution where possible (e.g. a voucher for the following year).

No right to a refund exists.

§ 16

Final Provisions

Should any individual provision be invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall remain unaffected.

Swiss law (CO) applies exclusively. The place of jurisdiction is the registered seat of the Organiser.
