

General Terms & Conditions

General

The following General Terms & Conditions (GTC) apply to the business relationship between the Swiss Association of Insurance and Risk Managers (SIRM) and the 'Participants of the SIRM Forum 2026'.

Please read the GTC carefully, as they serve as the basis for your visit and participation in the SIRM Forum 2026. They also serve as the basis for any use of information, materials or image rights related to or generated by the SIRM Forum.

By purchasing a ticket, you confirm your acceptance of the following General Terms & Conditions. Should you disagree with the GTC, we ask you to cancel the ticket purchase. The SIRM Forum 2026 is an event organised by the Swiss Association of Insurance and Risk Managers.

Under the GTC you agree that your contact details (1st name, last name, company and job title) provided at registration will be used for the following purposes:

- Preparation of name badges
- Preparation of the attendees list
- Emailing of information relevant to the SIRM Forum 2026

Registration

Registration for participation in the SIRM Forum 2026 is possible only by purchasing a ticket through the Eventfrog-link available at www.sirmforum.ch.

Tickets

Each ticket purchased for the main event of the SIRM Forum 2026 will require the 1st name, last name, company, job title, business email and dietary requirements of the participant. All ticket sales are final. Once purchased, tickets cannot be refunded or sold – the transfer of a ticket to another staff member of the same company is permitted. (Please see Special Ticket Conditions, Point 3.)

SIRM Forum 2026

Ticket Categories

- Participants outside the SIRM organisation can purchase tickets for the forum on 18 November 2026, at the price of CHF 860 (VAT included) per person.
- SIRM Partners 2026 can purchase tickets for the forum on 18 November 2026, at the Partner price of CHF 750 (VAT included) per person.
- SIRM Members can purchase tickets for the forum on 18 November, and the internal SIRM event on 19 November 2026, at the Member price of CHF 195 (VAT included).
- Two Member tickets can be selected for the price of one:
 - 1 for 1: if only one ticket is purchased
 - 2 for 1: if two tickets are purchased

Special Ticket Conditions

The 2026 event special ticketing conditions are applicable only on 18 & 19 November 2026 at the SIRM Forum in Kursaal Bern, Switzerland.

- SIRM Members can book only one additional free ticket for the same company with each purchased ticket. Please be aware that this is only possible within the same booking process. There is no limit to the number of tickets that can be bought, subject to availability.
This condition is applicable only for staff members from the same legal entity.
- Tickets bought for day one (18 November 2026), are valid only for this day and provide no right to join in or participate on the second day (19 November 2026).
- Tickets are generally non-transferable and can be used only by the participant whose name is mentioned on the ticket. An exception is made if a ticket is transferred to a staff member within the same legal entity. Ticket transfers must be requested by email to the event manager: weidmann@newbury.ch.
- The ticket price does not include hotel accommodation.

House Rules

With the purchase of a ticket and participation in the SIRM Forum 2026, each participant agrees to the house rules stipulated by www.kursaal-bern.ch

Photos & Videos

By attending the event, participants consent to having their pictures and videos taken. These images may be used by the event organisers and their partners on their website, social media and other platforms related to the event/organisation.

Attendee list

By attending the event, participants consent to their name and company being made available as part of the delegate list, which will be available for download at the Forum through a QR-code link (not available in advance).

Cancellations

All sales are final. A ticket refund is not possible.

Cloakroom

No liability will be accepted for the use of the cloakroom in the case of loss, damage or theft.

Food & Beverages

SIRM does not cover the cost of food and beverages (and any other items available for purchase) consumed at the bar at any time.

Allergies/Dietary Requirements

Allergies and dietary requirements must be mentioned when purchasing the ticket online. It is your responsibility to indicate allergies and dietary requirements upon ticket purchase and on-site to the staff members of the venue (Kursaal Bern) if needed. Any liability by SIRM is disclaimed.

Services

The scope of the contractual services of the SIRM Forum 2026 event is defined in the information documents and the details on our website: www.sirmforum.ch. We reserve the right to change the programme at any time without prior notice.

Limitation of Liability

SIRM liability is excluded, to the extent permitted by law, for any type of indirect, consequential or incidental damages. SIRM assumes no liability whatsoever for the health of the participants. In the event that third parties or authorities make complaints or claims against SIRM, the cause of which lies with participants not adhering to the rules of conduct, these claims will be forwarded to the party solely responsible. The participant is responsible in full and without any limitations for themselves, their health and their actions.

Relevant Court

These General Terms & Conditions shall be construed in accordance with Swiss law without regard to the conflict of laws, rules or principles thereof.

If a court of competent jurisdiction holds any provision of this document invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the enforceability of any other provision hereof and the remainder hereof shall continue in full force and effect. If any provision hereof should be deemed to exceed the time limitation permitted by applicable law, then the provision will be changed to the maximum time limitation permitted.

Update of General Terms & Conditions

These GTC are effective and will apply to your registration to the event.

We may update these GTC from time to time. Consequently, you are invited to regularly refer to the latest GTC in effect.

Competition & Antitrust Laws

Participants agree to adhere to governing competition and antitrust laws.
